- Grant funding will be awarded at the discretion of the SVS Board of Directors and Grants Peer Committee
- Grant recipient understands they will receive 50% of their grant upfront and will receive the remaining 50% when art project has been completed, produced, After Action report and expense form with receipts have been submitted to Sacramento Valley Spark.
- Grant recipient agrees to complete and produce to Sacramento Valley Spark Grant Peers Committee by **September 1, 2018**.
 - o Finished art project
 - o After Action Report with photographs of the art project
 - o Expense form filled out and copies of all receipts attached
- Monies must be spent on the items outlined in your grant application budget. Grant monies that are not spent on the project must be reimbursed to Sacramento Valley Spark.
- Grant monies must NOT be used for personal expenses unrelated to the art project.
- Grant recipient agrees to be prepared to display art at any one event in the Sacramento Region and surrounding areas or Burning man no later than **November 1, 2018**.
- In the event that Art is not completed, installed, displayed or performed as described prior to **November 1, 2018**, or in the event Grant recipient fails to comply with any other terms of this Agreement, Grant recipient will return Grant monies to Sacramento Valley Spark and be barred to apply for future grants.
- Only one grant per project will be allotted.
- Only one grant per person will be allotted.
- The only support Sacramento Valley Spark is agreeing to provide to the Artist is the Grant. Sacramento Valley Spark may, but shall not be required to, also provide volunteer support to assist Artist with the logistics of the Art. Any such support will be at Sacramento Valley Spark's sole discretion and the level of support, if any, offered may be changed or entirely eliminated at any time within Sacramento Valley Spark's sole discretion.
- Artist agrees to remove the Art and all remaining materials, supplies, and debris, and to restore the location where the Art was displayed or performed to substantially the same condition it was in before the Art was displayed and to do so no later than last day of the event or as described in the details of the installation site as specified on the grant application, unless the art was specifically defined as permanent art and all applicable local agreements have been completed. If Artist does not comply with this Paragraph Artist agrees to pay for all costs of removing the Art and restoring the location where it was exhibited to that condition's original location, including but not limited to, compensation for Sacramento Valley Spark staff and volunteers that perform this work.
- Artist along with all assistants, volunteers, and work crews related to the Art are required to pay for entrance to the events art is displayed at unless the Event negotiates otherwise.
